Why should I take the time to complete this survey?

- Your answers are an essential part of our town's effort to plan for future growth and to protect our natural, scenic, historic, and recreation resources things that make Conway a special place to live.
- Your answers will form the basis for an Open Space and Recreation Plan for Conway and will help the Town as it develops future land use policies and priorities.
- Your answers will remain anonymous and will be used for planning purposes only.

What is Open Space?

- Open space is generally defined as public or privately owned undeveloped land. In Conway, open space includes agriculture, forestland, meadow, wetland, streams and rivers, ridgeline and scenic views, and significant historical structures and landscapes.
- Open space may be important to Conway residents for a variety of reasons, including agriculture, forestry, wildlife habitat, water quality, climate resilience, recreation, or simply because of its scenic qualities and its contribution to the overall character of town.

What is an Open Space & Recreation Plan?

- It establishes goals and objectives to help guide Town decisions on land use, open space, and recreation.
- It qualifies Conway for federal and state funding for recreation and open space land.
- It provides the Select Board a framework for decision-making when Chapter 61 lands become available.
- It can be used to preserve our heritage, protect our natural and scenic resources, and ensure space for recreation while allowing growth and development to occur in ways that maintain the character of our community.

ALTERNATIVE TEXT:

The Town of Conway wants to know what you think! The Conway Open Space Committee is working with the Franklin Regional Council of Governments to update Whately's Open Space and Recreation Plan—a tool through which Whately plans for the future of its conservation and recreation resources. Once approved by the state, the plan also makes the community eligible for Department of Conservation Services grant funds for conservation and recreation projects for up to seven years.
