All scholarships shall be awarded using the information provided in the enclosed application. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered for an award unless there are extenuating circumstances approved which are approved by the scholarship committee.

Our scholarships are awarded to *any* graduating senior residing within Franklin County. If the graduating senior is a member or his/her family is a member of the Conway Sportsman's Club, then the residency requirement shall not apply.

Primary consideration will be given to an applicant's community/school involvement, academic achievements and any work history relative to the completion of the application.

All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship committee and the chosen applicants shall be notified in early May.

DEADLINE: April 20th. Applications postmarked after April 20th will not be considered.

- **3.** Submit a letter of recommendation, the recommendation letter should be written in a professional manner, signed and include the author's title, business or personal affiliation, how long they have known you and their contact information so the scholarship committee may contact them if needed.
