Item 1: Minutes of the Feb. 19, 2026, meeting APPROVED unanimously

Item 2: Wrap up of Pi Day: Our 3.14 event at the United Church drew about 35 people who came with pies (including one *actual* mud pie) to share, which Rachel proclaimed a success for the first-time event. Some felt we could have promoted the event earlier and perhaps more with schools to make it a more cross-generational event. Item 5: Planning progresses for the third Senior Social. A band has been found, but search continues for caterer for the May 9 event to be held between 5 and 7 p.m. at Field Memorial Library. Beverages and promotion still to be addressed.
