- Title V Report
 - 7/8 – 539 Graves Road – pump system add-on
 - 7/15 – 670 Shelburne Falls Road – perc test
 - 7/21 – 102 Delabarre – Title V (entire system failed)
- Health and Wellness
 - Jackie did another homebound clinic – 4 in Conway and 1 in Charlemont
 - 1 in 4 in U.S. have been infected / 1 in 6 in Franklin County
 - Franklin County is currently at a low community spread level per the CDC, but at a high transmission rate
 - Biobot now being used in some cities/towns to test the wastewater. These tests determine what variants are most common in the community and indicate what we might see coming.
 - Opioid Task Force – 2021 saw 49 overdose deaths in Franklin County. Task Force follows through with patients, family, and children. Addicts not only taking opioids, however, Narcan will only work with opioids, other life saving techniques are necessary.
 - Monkey Pox – WHO item of concern. Harder to spread, generally a mild disease. Opinion is that this will not be the next COVID. Spread by an extended period of skin-on-skin contact (at least three hours) or large respirator droplets.

 - Pool needs to be inspected
