The town may be responsible, as when brush is cut, it is left where it falls and likely causes at least a part of the problem. It might be possible to create a swale to help control how the water passes through.

Have a DEP number - should a site visit occur before the hearing or can we just ask him? We need to verify that the structure has been removed. The hearing is on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April. We should ask him to

notify us when the structure has been removed. Should there be a 200' area from the center of the stream. Accessory cabin has to be storage of equipment that goes with a house, thus part of a residence. But you can't use it to sleep in if it's an accessory structure. If a residence it must have septic. He is grandfathered in terms of being able to build, but has to abide by the current code. Grace will send out an email requesting a site visit. We can't sign off on the NOI until the building is taken down. It's part of the enforcement order. Site visit: 28<sup>th</sup>, Sunday, at 9 a.m. is planned.
