

## **Town of Conway Trash Sticker Information**

- Beginning October 7th all residents using the Town's transfer station must have the new vehicle decal and must affix a town trash sticker to trash bags.
- The vehicle permit decal for FY24 (valid until June 30, 2024) is blue and costs \$20 for the first decal, \$5 each additional decal. Each decal is marked with the license plate number.
- Use one sticker for one 35-gallon trash bag or two 16-gallon kitchen trash bags, and two stickers for contractor bags.
- The maximum weight for one sticker is 35 pounds of trash.
- If the weight exceeds 35 pounds, then an additional sticker must be attached.
- Each household receives 104 trash bag stickers with the purchase of a vehicle decal. Additional bag stickers can be purchased for \$1 each at the town office.
- Bird seed bags, feed bags, pellet bags, etc. can be used as trash bags with a sticker attached. There is a toter at the transfer station where these bags can be donated for others to use.
- **Recycling is required and mandatory** in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. All glass, metal, plastic, paper, including cardboard, are prohibited from trash disposal and must be recycled. Almost 50% of household trash can be recycled. You can recycle the following materials:
  - ✓ Paper (clean paper only)
  - ✓ Newspaper
  - ✓ Cardboard (please flatten boxes)
  - ✓ Plastics (containers smaller than 2.5 gallons)
  - ✓ Glass
  - ✓ Tin, steel and aluminum
  - ✓ Milk and juice cartons
