FY25

- Applied for and was awarded a MassWorks grant to address culvert replacements on Emerson Hollow Roads, install guardrails and pave 1000' of Shelburne Falls and repair/replace drainage infrastructure in the Pine Hill area; grant amount **\$521,550.00**
- MIIA Risk Management award of **\$6,544** for electrical disconnect for trash and paper compactors at transfer station
- Applying for MVP 2.0 in conjunction with Ashfield; grant amount **\$100,000**.

FY24

FLOOD RELATED FUNDING

Damage assessments for the July 10th & 21st storms totalled \$3,815,373.24

AWARDED \$1,245,000 by the state for repairs to the town's road infrastructure caused by the July 2023 storms.

MassDOT repaired five federally assisted roads in town, amounting to several million dollars worth of work.

Conway was granted many yards of gravel by MassDOT

Between these three sources of aid and funding, Conway was made whole and did not have to borrow funds.

FY23

- Applied for and was granted an MVP grant to address flooding in Conway Center; grant amount **\$279,000**.

- Annual Emergency Management Program Grant (EMPG) for **\$2,000**
- MassDOT replaced the North Poland bridge, which failed inspection in November of 2022, with a temporary bridge installed in February of 2023. Full replacement of the bridge, also at MassDOT's expense, will be completed in 2025.

FY22

- Had to decline the FY22 Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) grant award due to inability to meet grant match which was based on the purchase of 69 Main Street.

- Applied for Main Street America in conjunction with Field Memorial Library; application unsuccessful.

- Cybersecurity assessment grant for Conway's IT system and networks, performed by NorthEast IT; grant amount **\$8,587.71**, through MIIA Risk Management
