Pollinator Garden on the Library Island

In spring of 2022, *Pollinate Conway!*, a volunteer group of Conway residents, installed a pollinator garden above the granite wall on the island across from Field Memorial Library. As the garden demonstrates, many plant species native to the northeast are highly beneficial to local pollinators such as native bees and butterflies. We selected plants that will flower in succession over a long season, from early spring into autumn, providing nectar and pollen for the pollinators. Additionally, several species are host plants for caterpillars of native butterflies. Use this document as a guide to the 2022 garden plan and plant species. As the garden evolves over time, plant locations may shift; look for the plant labels as a guide to the species. For more information, scan the QR code below.
