

December 19, 2022 Town Administrator Update:

- I have received back 20 out of the 37 town priority polls I sent out, and the top five priorities according to town departments and committees are:
 - New Public Safety building
 - Land/Forest/Natural resources preservation & stewardship
 - A lift for the Town Hall and plan to move from Town Offices
 - Keeping taxes low
 - Hydraulic & hydrologic data on South River for flood control
- Bob Armstrong and I met with Malissa Labarre of Colonial Power to review Conway's aggregation data, and I created a new link on the website to explain about the program under 'About Conway'; "Conway's Municipal Aggregation".
- The Notice of Intent for the creation of the new Public Safety Building was submitted to both the Conservation Commission and MassDEP, and the committee will be attending a public hearing with the ConComm on the NOI on January 10th.
- Work has begun on the temporary bridge for North Poland Road. The bridge has not yet been built, but DOT has their permits and are preparing everything in anticipation of the arrival of the bridge.
- Chief Baker has found a truck for the Fire Department. He has followed procurement protocols with 3 quotes and hopes to turn in the old vehicle and pick up the new truck next week.
