Age-Friendly Conway I have submitted on behalf of AFC their invoices for FY26. They did an amazing job of expending the Mass in Motion funds with only \$1.27 leftover! Part of the funds pay for the Senior Social, and they have also ordered two tents, one of which will have 'Age-Friendly Conway' written across the top.

Highway Ron has submitted for Chapter 90 reimbursements for work in the Pine Hill area as well as South Shirkshire. His list of roads to be paved for FY27 include: Hart, Pine Hill (north), Roaring Brook, Saban and Thompson.
