



Conway Town Farm Forest Walk
June 18, 2022, 9:30am – 12noon
(rain date: June 19, 2022, same time)

You are invited to walk with local forester Mary Wigmore and DCR District Forester, Alison Hunter Wright through the 100-acre town-owned forest on Cricket Hill Road. They will lead a talk with your community about the forest's resiliency and its vulnerabilities to the predicted impacts of climate change on the ecosystem. Come explore the structural complexity and biodiversity of this hilltop forest ecosystem and learn how it can function as a nature-based climate solution.

Please wear sturdy shoes and bring water and bug repellent (ticks are common) as the hike will cover approximately 2 to 2.5 miles on rough terrain and will take about 2 to 2.5 hours of your time.
