## **Special Town Meeting**

13 January 2014

T A LEGAL TOWN MEETING of the inhabitants of the Town of Conway qualified to vote in town affairs, convened at the time and place and for the purpose specified in the warrant, 85 voters were checked at the door and issued salmon cards for the purpose of voting. Aina Barten, Jeanne Boyden, Lorraine Boyden and Sydney Ramey served as checkers. The meeting was called to order by Moderator J. Nicholas Filler and the meeting voted to dispense with the traditional reading of the warrant. The following action was taken by those persons in attendance:

**ARTICLE 1:** Unanimously voted to transfer \$13,000 from the undesignated funds account (free cash) for **an audit of Town funds.** 

Original article was amended by Selectmen to include the \$ amount and approved by voters.

**ARTICLE 2:** Voted that the Town **request legislation allowing Robert Baker to serve on the Fire Department until** his non-reappointment; provided, however, that deductions from the regular compensation of Robert Baker shall not be made under chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to his reaching the age of 65 in connection with his service to the town for retirement or pension purposes.

Article was amended from the floor to remove the age designation and approved by voters.

**ARTICLE 3:** Voted that the Town request legislation allowing Ronald Hawkes to serve on the Fire Department and the Police Department until his non-reappointment; provided, however, that deductions from the regular compensation of Ronald Hawkes shall not be made under chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to his reaching the age of 65 in connection with his service to the town for retirement or pension purposes.

Article was amended from the floor to remove the age designation and approved by voters.

**ARTICLE 4:** Voted that the Town transfer \$19,245.75 from insurance proceeds and \$23,000 from the capital stabilization account for the purpose of **replacing a Highway Department pickup truck,**Original article was amended by Selectmen to include the \$ amount and approved by voters.

Moderator declared a two-thirds majority of the article on a voice vote.

AT 8:15 p.m., MOTION WAS MADE and seconded and vote was taken to adjourn the meeting.
