



Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness (MVP) 2.0 Pilot

We are excited to pilot a new MVP planning program starting in spring 2023! The new MVP 2.0 program will provide communities with guidance and funding to:

- Expand their Core Team membership to center community members who will be most impacted by climate change
- Receive innovative virtual training on climate resilience best practices, equity, and environmental justice
- Reset priorities in their current MVP plans based on this new knowledge and engagement
- Receive technical assistance and guaranteed funding (anticipated at \$50,000) to develop and implement an action project

Details:

- The application for MVP 2.0 is expected to be released in late April 2023 and due in late May 2023
- Applicants may apply individually or as a region
- This grant is expected to be awarded around August 2023, with a June 2025 project end date (this includes time for resetting planning priorities and implementation of an action project)
- This grant is open to MVP communities who have undergone the original MVP Planning Grant process with preference to communities with the oldest MVP plans (i.e., plans completed around 2017/2018)
- Up to five communities in each region will be awarded funding in this FY24 pilot
- After this pilot round, we plan to require all communities to undertake this process to maintain future action grant eligibility starting with the oldest MVP plans
- More details will be covered in an informational session about the new program to be scheduled for April 2023
